The 2019 Open Conference will be hosted in the 14th Century venue *Certosa di Pontignano* located in the vast Chianti countryside of Siena, Italy. The address is: **Località Pontignano, 5, 53019 Pontignano SI, Italy.**



Travel Information

Travelling to and from Siena

Siena is located in the heart of Italy, therefore it can be reached from multiple airports. Although Siena does not have an airport, it is well connected to a number of airports:

- **Florence:** Amerigo Vespucci International Airport
- **Pisa:** G. Galilei International Airport
- **Perugia:** Sant'Egidio International Airport
- **Bologna:** Guglielmo Marconi International Airport

We therefore advise you to fly to one of the abovementioned airports, which are located the closest to Siena. They are all well connected to the city (either by train or bus). Please note that *Uber* is not available in the area.

Arrival at Certosa

All guests should arrive in Siena on Wednesday, 3rd July. You will either be arriving at the Central Station in Siena, or the bus station in Piazza Gramsci (or Viale Tozzi) in the city centre. The bus S34 connects the station to the Certosa di Pontignano, or you can take a taxi for the fixed price of 20 Euros. The journey from Siena to the Certosa di Pontignano takes about 20 minutes (40 minutes by bus).

Departure from Certosa

Please note that an accommodation option in the Certosa is available (please read below). Should you decide to sleep elsewhere, please note that the last event of the day (Social Event) will be finishing by midnight, and we would require all guests to depart from the venue by that time.

R is one of the most used tools for statistical analysis. R Studio and its packages are free to use, with an engaged community of users that improve its features every day. One of the main strengths of R is its great graphic power, being capable of producing high quality static, dynamic, and interactive graphics. This workshop is a great opportunity to familiarise yourself with R known to be extremely useful for behavioral scientists.

Opening Ceremony

Professor Caterina Suitner (University of Padova) will act as the Scientific Chair of the 2019 Open Conference. Additionally, she will introduce participants to the *role of meritocracy in the justification of economic system* as part of the Opening Ceremony.

Poster Session

This event will see students and academics from all over the world presenting their psychological research during the open-aired Poster session.

Dinner

A 3- course dinner under the medieval arches of the venue will follow the Poster Session. Please inform us should you have any dietary requirement (vegetarian or vegan diet, intolerances, allergies etc.)

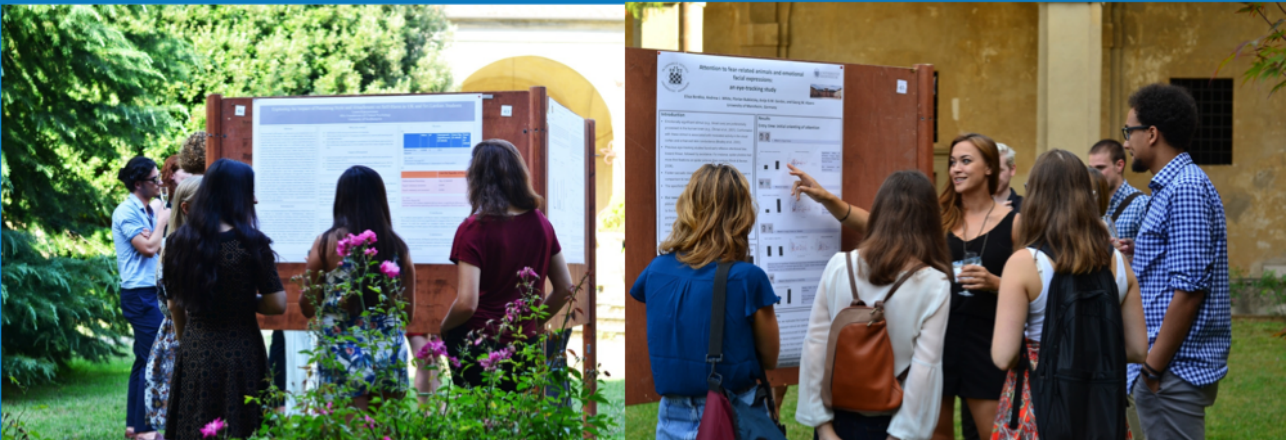
