A 5 week internship at King's College London

When?

Starting Monday 25th July and ending Saturday 27th August

For whom?

All JRP alumni (6 applicants will be selected)

What more?

Besides getting to spend a summer in the vibrant city of London, you will get to work closely with professional researchers from King's College, the fourth oldest university in England and ranked in the top 20 universities in the world. You will be based in the Psychology Department, one of the world's largest academic groupings of clinical and health psychologists, at the Guy's Hospital Campus in the heart of London. Included in the internship is attendance at the JRP Conference* in Cambridge, where you will be presenting your work at the JRP Alumni Day on the 16th of August.

What's in it for me?

This internship offers research experience at a top school in the UK with a chance of publishing the outcome of your work. It is a unique opportunity to deepen your knowledge and experience about psychometrics and systematic reviews.



Costs?

The internship is fully self-funded, however possibilities of applying for funding exist and the organising team is happy to help out. Estimated cost for the whole internship will be around £1400. This covers accommodation, including breakfast. Other meals, travel and the JRP conference are not included. As always, we are constantly working on lowering this cost.
